1. 2,500 hours fixed-wing total time
2. 500 hours fixed-wing turbine
3. 500 hours fixed wing multi-engine or single engine military fighter time
4. Flight Management Computer experience is highly recommended
5. Current ATP written exam
6. Current First Class Medical
7. Bachelor's Degree from an accredited College or University
8. Current Passport
9. Recommendations from two pilots you have flown with and two community leaders you have worked for.
10. Actively working in the community or with a community organization.
